1. By Spring weigh in, dairy feeder steers are to be: de-horned, castrated, and be properly vaccinated.
2. Exhibitors 12 years of age and under will be eligible to enter one (1) feeder steer in the large animal auction.
3. Dairy feeder steers are to be tied with a halter and neck tie until removed from the fair.
4. Dairy feeder steers are to be weighed in April, at the same site and date of the sheep weigh in. Dairy feeder steers must not weigh over 275 pounds at weigh-in in the spring.
5. Dairy (i.e. Holstein, Brown Swiss, Guernsey, Jersey, Ayrshire, or Milking Shorthorn).
6. Dairy feeders wanting to also show in open class...see Open Class Dairy Grade.

4. Group classes shall be made up as follows:
 - a. Get of Sire: 3 animals from one sire, any age, get of one sire.
 - b. Produce of Dam: Two animals, either sex, any age, produce of one cow.
 - c. Breeders Young Herd: 1 bull under 1 year, 3 females under 2 years.
 - d. Best Pair of Females owned by exhibitor
5. Bulls over one year must be secured by a proper ring in the nose to the satisfaction of the superintendent.
6. It shall be the responsibility of each exhibitor to be prepared to show registration papers if required by the fair association.

THE FOLLOWING RULES PERTAIN TO THE BEEF FEEDING PROJECT

1. Steers must be of beef breeding and be a Youth or FFA project.
2. The steer shown and sold at the Clare County Fair Livestock Auction MUST be ear tagged at the weigh in held annually on the First Saturday in December. To enter the rate of gain contest, the steers must also be weighed at this time. Members are limited to tagging two steers for the Clare County Fair.
3. Weigh in will determine the rate of gain and divide animals into four approximately equal weight classes.
4. The steer entered in the rate of gain contest must be the steer sold at the Clare County Fair Auction.
5. Each member may sell only one animal in the beef division. Only prime, choice and good steers will be sold individually at the Clare County Fair Auction. Standard steers will be grouped for sale. Owners of standard graded steers or lower may withdraw their animals from the sale.
6. Owners of steers must be present to show and sell their steers except by permission of the Hardship Committee.
7. All steers will be tied with a rope halter and necktie until removed from the fair.
