SPECIAL NOTICE:

1. Youth open class is anyone 6 years thru 19 years. (**Departments 60-72**)
2. Adult open class is anyone 19 years and older. Youth ages 6-19 years of age may also enter open class with project not from their youth projects. All projects will be judged on items not age.

OPEN CLASS GENERAL RULES

1. **Entry fees** for exhibits in the Home Arts Department will be \$ 3.00 per sheet. (Official entry form, 17 lines) **Pre-entry is required** and postmarked no later than **June 26, 2021**. ALL ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY FORM.
2. **TAGGING OF EXHIBITS:** Items may be tagged at home. Class tags will be available for pick up the Monday before the entry date. Tags may be picked up at the fair office please call for office hours: ANY alterations made to the tags by the exhibitor will be a disqualification of that item. Additional fees for tags needing to be reprinted once tags have been picked up will be 1-24 tags \$5.00; 25 and more \$10.00
3. **ENTRY DATE FOR OPEN HOME ARTS EXHIBITS** - except baked goods, fresh vegetables and flowers:
SATURDAY, JULY 17, 2021, 10:00 - 3:00 pm
4. **ENTRY DATE FOR PERISHABLE ITEMS:** SATURDAY, July 24, 2021 FROM 10:AM TO 3:00 PM.
5. **RELEASE HOURS:** SUNDAY, August 1, 2021 BETWEEN 9:00 AM & 1:00PM. NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ARTICLES LEFT AFTER THIS TIME. Exhibitors will forfeit premium and/or ribbon awarded if removed before release time stated.
6. Any article improperly entered will be reclassified.
7. Entries stained, soiled, defaced or otherwise in poor condition are not eligible for premiums. Only complete articles may be exhibited.
8. All articles in this department must be the work or the product of the exhibitor.
9. Any article placed for exhibit may not be re-exhibited for a period of two (2) years.
10. Only exhibitor tickets and placing ribbons shall be attached to articles on display.
11. Best Display Award in classes where a first place only premium is awarded is not a pre-entered class, but is at the judge's discretion from articles displayed.
12. No more than one article can be entered in one class.
13. Where there is only one entry in a class, the judge shall decide the premium.
14. Placing ribbons will be awarded with premiums as indicated. Honorable Mention ribbons will be awarded in various areas at the judge's discretion.
15. Any other general fair rules in front of this book also apply to this department.
16. No boxed or pre-packaged mixes allowed in baked goods.
17. **SPECIAL AWARDS** will be awarded in various areas at the judge's discretion. Award will be given on the basis of workmanship in this present year as displayed and not upon age of the article.
18. For classes under the educational projects or demonstration projects categories, participants are limited to youth who are 6-19 years of age by January 1st of the fair year.

Youth Home Art Rule

1. Youth Division judging for the following departments will take place on Friday, JULY 24, 2021 from 4:30pm until 7:30 pm. Department 60 thru 72 including horse educational projects.
2. Items may be tagged at home. Class tags will be available for pick up the Monday before the entry date. Tags may be picked up at the fair office between the hours of 9am-3pm. ANY alterations made to the tags by the exhibitor will be a disqualification of that item. Additional fees for tags needing to be reprinted once tags have been picked up will be 1-24 tags \$5.00; 25 and more \$10.00
3. Youth will take project to the judge's table to be judged. Youth will be given an A, B, or C rating. Ribbons will be handed out at the judge's table.
4. Youth will take project back to the club display area. All youth projects should be displayed with club booth except baked goods.
5. Club booths will be assigned. Each club is responsible for decorating and displaying their booth. Cleaning/Decorating can take place before open judging (7/5/21 to 7/16/21) and needs to be done by Friday, July 16, 2021. Call the fair office for times the Home Arts barn will be open. Displaying of projects needs to be completed Friday, July 24, 2021. Displaying will take place the day of judging and needs to be completed by Friday night 9pm.
6. Best Home Arts Club Display will be given out Monday of fair week.
7. Parents will not be allowed at the judging table.
8. Youth Home Arts is open to exhibitors that are residents of Clare County, enrolled in a Clare County school district, or are enrolled in a Clare County organized 4-H or Club.
9. BEST OF SHOW AND HONORABLE MENTION will be awarded at the judge's discretion.
